August winners were:

- Former urban infrastructure minister Alan Tudge for his (halting) statement that the all sites chosen for the \$660 million National Commuter Car Park Fund were based on need. The Australian National Audit Office found that site selection was actually based on a 'top 20 marginals' list - the existence of which Tudge denied
