# Home Networking - What ?

- Connecting any 'Computer-type' devices
  - **PCs, Tablets, Phones, GPS**
  - **Smart TV, Smart Watches, Fitbit-type devices**
  - **Printers, Modems, Routers, Network Storage**
  - **Keyboards, Mouse, Remote Controllers etc**

# Home Networking - Why ?

- Access / Share files
  - **Across two PCs, Phone ex PC, Smart TV / Media Centre**
  - **Remote Access - from any Internet point . . ( not tonight )**
- Transfer Data
  - **Phone (or Camera) to PC, PC to Network Storage**
- Share Peripherals
  - **Printer, Network Storage, Internet Access**

# Home Networking - How ?



- Connectivity ? Distance ?
  - Sneakernet - USB stick, distance = as needed . .
  - Ethernet Cable ( 'Blue', rj45 plug) – 100m Cat-5, 200m Cat-6
  - Wi-Fi Wireless Connection - 50m ? Confusion with 3 or 4 G ?
  - - - other means outside tonight's agenda - -
  - BlueTooth - 10m (between Paired devices)
  - Infra Red / Radio Frequency – 25m line-of-sight (usually)



# Home Network Achievements

- Shared Internet Access
  - **Blue Cable to PC and TV, Wi-Fi to Laptop and Phone**
  - **Saves dramatically on phone's data allowance**
- Shared Data
  - **Network Attached Storage (NAS) via USB or Ethernet**
  - **Data shared across NAS and PCs, Laptop, and Phone**
  - **TV can show Pictures, Video and Music from PCs or NAS**
  - **Smart TV can access Internet directly**
- Shared Peripherals
  - **Laptop can access printer ( either via PC or Router )**

# Home Networking - How ?



- Setup Connectivity
  - **Multi-Port Router (preferably with Wi-Fi)**
  - **Ethernet Cable (blue, rj45) to fixed devices**
  - **Router setup as DHCP Host, Devices to use DHCP**
    - ie. Router provides local network addresses**
  - **Router setup for Wi-Fi - change default admin & user passwords**
  - **Wi-Fi setup on Portable devices - Laptop, Phone etc**

# Home Networking - How ?

- Test Connectivity
  - **On PC, look at File Explorer / Network to see other devices**
- Two Options
  - **Home Group** – Windows feature , single Password, automated sharing of media and printers
  - **Selective File Sharing** and Printer ?

# Home Group option

- **Simpler option** for Windows PCs,  
provides auto sharing of media directories
- Limited sharing with Apple and Android devices
- Provides DLNA media sharing function for TVs etc
  - Distributed Living Network Alliance –
- Also UPnP (Universal Plug and Play)

# File Sharing Option

- Test Connectivity
  - **On PC, look at File Explorer / Network to see other devices**
- Arrange File and Printer Sharing
  - **Decide on Directories / Files to be shared – on each device**
  - **File Explorer, select files, Rt Click -> Properties, Share with .  
Select Users (at home, usually everyone)**
  - **For Printer, go to Control Panel / Printers / Printer Properties /  
Share With . . .**

# Security Comparisons

- Home Group
  - **Other PCs need 8ch Home Group psw for access**
  - **Then open to anyone who can logon to that PC**
- File Sharing . . .
  - **Users on other device(s) each need assigned access**
  - **Setup at either Directory or individual file levels**
  - **Can then control which Users have access, R only or R/W**
  - **Can use “Everyone” where lesser security needed**

# File Synchronisation

- Automatic Windows methods
  - **One Drive in Cloud - create sync file on PCs etc**
- Third party Controlled . . .
  - **Free File Sync - both Real Time and user Controlled**
  - **My favourite for syncing Eudora Mail from main PC to development PC, two laptops and a Stick PC**
  - **FFS can also sync to Apple and Linux (no Android ? )**
  - **Has a Real-Time Option - not used by me . .**





# Some Issues

- Media Centre bridge for older TVs (ie. not Smart)
- DLNA option useful for TVs (or Media Centres)
- Easiest if common user logons across PCs
- Care needed if allowing external Read/Write access
- Be sure to change default passwords on Wi-Fi routers !
